


## Recognition and Management of the Seriously III Patient (RAMSI)

When a crisis occurs, working within a team is critical so therefore training together makes sense, the RAMSI course enables Doctors and Nurses to train together, developing skills required to recognise and care for acutely ill patients on the adult ward.

Using simulation-based education, the course focuses on a systematic approach to caring for seriously ill patients with an emphasis on team dynamics, communication skills, leadership and situational awareness. The course runs over a full day and is free to all NHS employees throughout the Yorkshire and Humber region.
