



Human Factors for F2 Doctors

Objectives:

This one day course explores the interaction of clinicians with their environment. It explores human error and limitations in order to teach effective management of critical incidents.

Based on simulated scenarios in a variety of hospital settings, the course aims to demonstrate and improve non-technical skills such as leadership, communication, team working and decision making. The course uses a high-fidelity adult manikin and audio-visual feedback to assist supportive debriefing.
